

# Resurrection Facts

Paul wrote extensively about the body that will be given at the resurrection when Jesus returns. There are some things about that body we cannot presently know, but we can know enough about it to ignite our interest, hope or fear. Here are a few resurrection facts.

## 1. Last trumpet, end of time, resurrection day (1 Cor 15:52; 22-24).

- It will be “the last day” (John 6:39-40, 44, 54).
- It will occur at an “hour” on the “last day” (John 5:28-29).
- It will be the Judgment Day (Rev 20:12-15).

## 2. New body prepared for God’s eternal kingdom (1 Cor 15:50).

- It will be like Jesus Christ’s “glorious body” (Phil 3:20-21).
- He does not live in a fleshly body (John 2:19-21; Luke 24:39).
- “Flesh and blood [or bones] cannot inherit the kingdom of God”.
- His resurrected body was “glorified” to live in heaven (John 17:5).

## 3. New body for everyone (1 Cor 15:51-52; 21-22).

- Everyone who faithfully served God and Christ.
- Everyone who did not serve God and Christ.
- Dispensed on the resurrection day (John 5:28-29; Acts 24:15).

What kind of body will you be given on the resurrection day? One prepared for an eternal life in Heaven (1 John 3:2-3)? Or one prepared for eternal condemnation in the lake of fire (Rev 20:14-15)? One body will stand up to the intense power of the glory of God. The other body will stand up to the intense heat of the wrath of God. Which body does your spirit wish to inhabit? Are you ready for the resurrection day? “Repent and be baptized...in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins...” (Acts 2:38).
